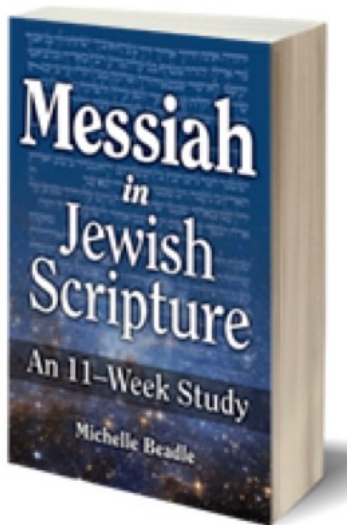
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MESSIAH IN JEWISH SCRIPTURE

I am feeling much better than I did the last time I was in touch with you through a newsletter. To tell the truth, I had really given up hope, but I definitely have it now. I can now walk around my block and participate in exercises once again.
