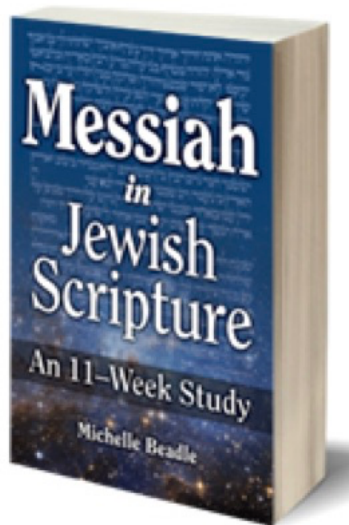
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MESSIAH IN JEWISH SCRIPTURE

Our monthly Bible study will not meet in June, July, or August due to summer vacation. We will resume on the first Sunday of September to celebrate Rosh Hashanah together.

A CELEBRATION OF LIFE

We recently observed *shiva* (a traditional seven-day intensive mourning period observed in Judaism) for Merryl, the wife of Tony Eaton, the first leader of Simchat Yisrael, who passed away on Tuesday, May 5, after she had posted the original version of “*Stairway to Heaven*” by Led Zeppelin on Facebook. (Not a coincidence.)

In Jewish tradition, those who know the deceased gather with the family, bringing food for meals to sustain them during the first week of mourning, and recite the Kaddish. This central Jewish prayer honors the deceased and focuses on praising God’s name rather than lamenting death. Composed in Aramaic, it aims to provide comfort to the bereaved. This prayer exalts God amid death.

The words to the Mourner’s Kaddish in English are as follows:

Glorified and sanctified be God’s great name throughout the world which He has created according to His will.

May He establish His kingdom in your lifetime and during your days, and within the life of the entire House of Israel, speedily and soon; and say, Amen.

May His great name be blessed forever and to all eternity.

Blessed and praised, glorified and exalted, extolled and honored, adored and lauded be the

name of the Holy One, blessed be He, beyond all the blessings and hymns, praises and consolations that are ever spoken in the world; and say, Amen.

May there be abundant peace from heaven, and life, for us and for all Israel; and say, Amen.

He who creates peace in His celestial heights, may He create peace for us and for all Israel; and say, Amen.
